

Eligible cars TOYO TIRES 24hSeries

Below an overview is given of the eligible cars for the TOYO TIRES 24hSeries.

This is applicable for:

- 12hHungaroring, 26-27 September 2008, Hungary
- 24hValencia, 10-11-12 October 2008, Spain

- And the 4th edition of TOYO TIRES 24hDubai, 8-9-10 January 2009, Dubai (also the amendments in the regulations compared with above races are mentioned)

Eligible Cars TOYO TIRES 24hSeries

In general cars up to 4000cc / 6 cylinders

- Touring cars
- GT Cars
- 24H Special cars
- Silhouette cars
- Cup cars
- Exceptional cars (more than 4000cc and/or more than 6 cylinders) with a Weight/Power ratio of 3,7 KG/HP or more.

Classes (petrol and diesel)

For Petrol:

A1	Up to 1600 cc
A2	1600cc - 2000cc
A3	2000cc - 2500cc
A4	2500cc - 3000cc
A5	3000cc - 3500cc
A6	3500cc - 4000cc

For Diesel (gas oil):

D1	Up to 2000cc
D2	2000cc - 3000cc

Special Groups:

SP1 Group Silhouette Cars up to 3600 cc

SP2 Group Exceptional Cars (more than 4000cc and/or more than 6 cylinders) with a Weight/Power ratio of 3,7 KG/HP or more.

Differences between regulations 24hSeries2008 and 24hSeries2009.

Apart from the fact that in 2009 for all races the HANS system will be compulsory, there are some amendments in class A6 (3500-4000cc). Note that for 2008 Hans is only compulsory for 24hValencia.

To increase competition in class A6 (3500-4000cc) the minimum weight and the max fuel tank capacity in this class have been amended.

The table below shows the amendments.

Class A6 (3500-4000cc)

3500 – 3750 cc	1225 kg / 120 Litre	1200 kg / 120 Litre
3750 – 4000 cc	1275 kg / 120 Litre	1300 kg / 90 Litre

With the weight advantage of a Porsche GT3 cup spec and the fuel tank limitation of the RSR, the performance gap will be much smaller. So the racing skills of the driver will be much more of importance.

Although the weight difference of 100kg between a Porsche cup and Porsche RSR, the maximum weight of the RSR is not increased due to the reduction of the maximum Fuel capacity to 90 litres.
